Rehabilitation of people with disabilities is a process aimed at enabling them to reach and maintain their optimal physical, sensory, intellectual, psychological and social functional levels... to attain independence and self-determination (WHO)










ICF biopsychosocial model (WHO)














Role of Cochrane Fields a bridge
