

Dr. Frane Grubišić, MD, PhD (Croatia)

Dr. Grubišić currently serves as the Head of the Division of the Adult Rheumatology in the Department of Rheumatology, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation in the University Hospital Centre «Sestre Milosrdnice» in Zagreb, Croatia. The same Department serves as the Referral Centre for the Spondyloarthropathies (of the Ministry of Health) and as the European Training Centre for PRM. He is member of the Steering Committee of several scientific organizations (Croatian Rheumatological Society, Croatian Society of PRM), president of the Croatian League Against Rheumatism (patient organization), liaison officer for European League Against Rheumatism-Patients with Arthritis and Rheumatism in Europe and national delegate to PRMESPRM and national delegate to European League Against Rheumatism Standing Committee of Epidemiology and Health Services Research. After graduating from the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb in 1998, he finished his mandatory internship in the University Hospital “Sestre Milosrdnice” in Zagreb. In 2001-2005 period he finished his residency in PRM, followed by the residency in rheumatology from 2006-2008. As for his academic degrees, he successfully finished two postgraduate studies: “Physical medicine and rehabilitation” (part of residency education) in 2003-2004 and “Biomedical sciences” with a master of science obtained in 2009. Since 2001, he has been actively involved in both undergraduate and postgraduate study in subjects related to PRM. During the same period, he also teaches at the School of Kinesiology, University of Zagreb. His scientific work and research activities are related to inflammatory rheumatic diseases, low back pain, biomechanics and epidemiology of rheumatic and musculoskeletal diseases. As for his publishing activities, he is currently editor-in-chief of the scientific magazine “PRM”, the official journal of the Croatian Society for PRM.
