

Aydan Oral is a professor in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation in Istanbul University, Istanbul Faculty of Medicine, Istanbul, Turkey, since 1996. She acted as the Chair (2008-2011) and the 'Residency Training Program Coordinator' in the PM&R department (2007 – 2014). One of her previous positions was the founding directorship of the Istanbul University Research and Application Center for Students with Disabilities (2003 - 2005). She served as the editor of the Turkish Journal of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (1998-2000) and the Journal of Istanbul Faculty of Medicine (2005-2009). Her major areas of interest in PRM include musculoskeletal diseases including osteoporosis, cardiac rehabilitation, post-mastectomy rehabilitation, hand rehabilitation, functional assessment, the ICF, and disability issues. She has national and international scientific publications and has been lecturing in scientific events relevant to her areas of interest.
