

Dr Bérangère Gohy works for the international non-governmental organisation Humanity&Inclusion (HI) as a global specialist in evidence-based rehabilitation. In this role, she is responsible for informing the evidence-based rehabilitation interventions implemented by HI. This position focuses specifically on measuring the outcomes of rehabilitation interventions implemented by HI, for routine monitoring, learning and research purposes. Dr Gohy has also experience in the provision and technical support of rehabilitation interventions in health emergencies and during complex humanitarian crises.

She has recently completed a PhD in Physiotherapy at the Karolinska Institutet (Sweden). The thesis focused on the recovery of different aspects of functioning after injury in different humanitarian settings. The studies included the development and psychometric evaluation of an outcome measurement, as well as a multicenter longitudinal study assessing the factors associated with recovery of independence, including rehabilitation.
