Dave Muller is currently Editor in Chief of Disability and Rehabilitation. The Journal now publishes 26 Issues a year and has expanded from having just 4 Issues and no copy! It is now a highly ranked and well-respected Journal. As a psychologist his focus has been on methodology and evidence-based practice.

Disability and Rehabilitation is a multi-disciplinary publication with a significant International reach. The Associate Editors and the Editorial Board take a very broad view of rehabilitation and publish a wide range of topics and methodological approaches. Throughout there is a strong emphasis on intervention.

He is also a co-editor with Professor Marcia Scherer of a book series on 'Rehabilitation Science in Practice' published by CRC . There are now over twenty texts published, and more are being commissioned. Linked to this he has over the last few years edited a number of related texts working with colleagues from Australia and the USA.

His early career was as a lecturer and researcher in the field of health and he was a Founder Editor of the Journal "Aphasiology". He then took on a series of senior managerial roles and was instrumental in forming the University of Suffolk in the UK where he is now a Visiting Professor of Rehabilitation Psychology.
