I give consultations in outdoor (weekly average 200- 230 patients), perform EMG/NCS, do injection procedures and attend indoor calls. Majority of the OPD patients present with musculoskeletal problems like back pain, various forms of arthritis and Fibromylagia. Most paediatric patients have Cerebral palsy, while other have problems like congenital clubfoot and Neural tube defects. Most of the indoor patients are from orthopaedic, neurology and plastic surgery.
- I am in the faculty of the Bahria University Medical and Dental College as assistant professor in Rehabilitation Medicine. I deliver lectures and conduct bedside teaching and small group discussion with the under-graduate students. Focus is on musculoskeletal medicine, rheumatology, peripheral neurology, childhood and adult disabilities.
