

David Morgenroth, MD is Associate Professor of Rehabilitation Medicine at the University of Washington (Seattle, WA, USA). He is also Associate Director of the Amputee Rehabilitation Fellowship at VA Puget Sound Health Care System and is a Core Investigator in the VA RR&D Center for Limb Loss and Mobility (CLiMB). He serves as Association of Academic Physiatrists (AAP) Chair of the Research Committee, Member of the Board of Trustees, and on the Advisory Board for the Rehab Medicine Scientist Training Program. He is also an Associate Editor for the Archives of PM&R Journal

Dr. Morgenroth's clinical care and research focuses on improving mobility and quality of life in those with anatomic or functional limb loss.
